- The Beginner division is reserved exclusively for competitors who are eligible to have or get a AQHA-NOVICE Amateur, AQHA-NOVICE Youth or NRHA-ROOKIE card.
- Beginner may show twohanded on Snafflebit or Hackamore or onehanded on a Bit even senior horses.
- In all WRAL-classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
- Trail in Hand APHA rules will be applied
- Horse&Dog-Trail EWU rules will be applied

FLSE classes: (just for FLSE licensed riders): AQHA rules are applied with the following exception:

- In Youth and Open classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
